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**ORDER**

The commission reviewed the complaint filed in this matter and found that the complainant's allegations regarding the judge's temperament during the proceeding were not supported by the recording of the hearing. It also found that the judge was not aware of and did not rule on the complainant's motion until he received a copy of the complaint against him. Even so, he accepted full responsibility for the problem and immediately implemented procedures to avoid similar problems in the future.

The complaint is dismissed pursuant to Rule 16(a) and the matter is closed.

I do not understand why Judge [redacted] only took 2 months to decide my divorce case, but has allowed almost 2 years to go by with out deciding my "reasonable fees."

I am suffering financially due to his willful and persistent failure to perform his duties and rule. This is a violation of my rights and has caused me a terrible financial set back. My lawyer is going to send another letter
