**ORDER**

The commission reviewed the complaint filed in this matter and found no misconduct on the part of the judge.

The complainant alleged that the judge should not have granted an order of protection filed by the complainant's wife because she was a friend of the judge's wife. The investigation revealed that when the judge learned of the relationship, he immediately recused himself from the case.

The complainant also alleged that the judge exceeded the maximum allowable contributions to a political candidate. The commission's investigation revealed that it was the judge's wife, not the judge, who exceeded the limit, contrary to the judge's wishes.

The complaint is dismissed pursuant to Rule 16(a).
