ORDER

The commission reviewed the complaint and concluded that the judge's staff had received the motion but failed to process the document promptly so that the judge could rule on the matter. When the motion was brought to his attention, the judge immediately ruled on it and promptly implemented more stringent procedures to make sure the problem does not occur again. Accordingly, the commission dismissed the complaint and reminded the judge of his obligation to require his staff to observe the standards of diligence that apply to him.

The complaint is dismissed pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23(a) and the matter is closed.
