My name is [redacted] I want to file a complaint against Judge [redacted] of the [redacted] Superior Court of [redacted] AZ.

My family and I went to the courthouse today to file a Petition for an order of protection against my [redacted] mother. The case number is or was [redacted]

My family and especially myself are in danger from [redacted] the one I filed a petition against. We are originally from [redacted] and have had TWO separate orders of protection against her before.

Today at court I brought tape recorded threats, messages of her harrassment and the danger she is posing. I also brought with me violent pictures of her, life threatening emails from her, harrassing emails from her etc. I brought the 2 [redacted] Police reports we have filed against her.

I brought much more evidence than listed above. I asked the judge for the order he asked why I told him, he said no because it sounds like a "Custody Issue". I asked if he could PLEASE look over my evidence, reports etc, he said no. I begged once more to the judge and expressed that this is very important to protect my family and I and that even my elderly parents are being harrassed, and he said no again.

He denyed my petition formally refused to let me speak further on the matter and continued after that to approve the petitions for protection of the women that were waiting in the court room.

There evidences were that their boyfriend took their keys and wouldn't give them back. I witness 2 cases where nothing but the word of 2 females were presented before the judge and he granted their orders.

I want a complaint filed, my case reveiwed and I want a chance to have a Judge ACTUALLY look over my paper work and police reports and other evidence so I can be protected according to Arizona's laws and by my rights as a citizen who IS in danger!
