To Whom it may concern, (August 15th 2006)
 My name is [redacted] and I
 come bearing a complaint of misconduct
 against Judge [redacted] in the
 [redacted] Justice Court. My complaint
 is as follows:

- ① On [redacted] I was cited and released
 for [redacted] and promised to
 appear on (i.e. [redacted]) at which time
 I failed to appear on [redacted]
- ② On [redacted] I was cited and released
 again on [redacted] I failed to appear again
 (i.e. [redacted])

③ Then on [redacted] @ 9:24 am I appeared
 in person and paid \$45⁰⁰ ea x 2 = \$90⁰⁰ for
 the formal "quash Warrant fee". At this
 same time I was seen in front of Judge
 [redacted] and the matter was continued
 until 30 calendar days. I was ordered
 at this time to pay approximately [redacted]
 upon my return after the 30 days
 expired.

on [redacted] (25 days after) I was queried by [redacted] police Dept. OO I waited for my daughter outside of Walgreens @ [redacted]

The officer ([redacted]) did a routine check and found 2 (two) warrants still active out of [redacted] One warrant [redacted] was confirmed. The second warrant [redacted] was not confirmed at that time.

I was booked into [redacted] Jail on the above former [redacted] I then posted bond in the amount of [redacted] and released to appear again approximately 72 hours later.

As you will see by the attached copies of receipts @ and Warrants @ that I submit the warrants remained active that were issued [redacted] and [redacted] until my subsequent arrest.

My Complaint is simple;

on [redacted] I paid \$15.00 ea. x 2 = \$90.00 to squash for mentioned warrants and it was agreed and ordered setting the matter out 30 days to allow permit me to pay the amount in full.

I fear of the events on 2006 I have been scared out of my wits to appear in person @ [redacted] citing a sheer haunting fear that why Judge [redacted] thinks he can get away with such blatant abuse of his authority.

I feel that Judge [redacted] has shown bias through his abuse possible because my husband [redacted] had at the same approximate time filed a complaint on him prior to this incident #56 [redacted]

Please investigate the conduct of Judge [redacted] at the earliest convenience as it's behavior is unbecoming of a Justice in Arizona
