First, the honorable Judge [] was wrong and showed partiality
when suggesting to [] "you are free to have an order against
him, thats fine." Without telling [] not to submit any
unnecessary or frivolous complaints.

Judge [] was not patient or courteous at differant times.
Particularly, considering the fact that I had informed the court in
filed pleadings of [] That I was having physical
and emotional problems.

I am a Disabled American Viet Nam era Veteran. I have several
disabilities that are aggravated and negatively affected by emotional
distress.

I am not big and strong handsome guy like [] nor
am I [] However, these things should not
interefere with an impartial hearing.

[] was allowed to go on and on with hearsay. Yet,
when I raise my hand to object, after I had already been warned,
"No further interuptions" for saying one word, "AZMACOURT".

I am yelled at and warned again for a second time. I said one (1)
word and had two warnings from Judge []

[redacted] goes on, bringing [redacted] into it. On [redacted] I saw from my kitchen window [redacted] bring his cut grass shavings and dump them across the street from him. There is a picture. The police came and saw the cut grass dumped on the vacant lot, just to the south of me, and across the street from [redacted]. The police entered illegal dumping on their police information card. There is no other grass for miles that I know of. It was also freshly grass cuttings and very obvious that [redacted] had just cut his grass and had dumped it on the vacant lot to the police.

Again regarding [redacted] which the judge allowed [redacted] to go on and on about. The real problem began on [redacted] when [redacted] [redacted] came TO OUR FRONT DOOR COMPLAINING about police at his door on Saturday.

On [redacted] [redacted] came to our front courtyard again banging on the door. Police were dispatched and [redacted] admitted to the police that he had been told not to come back on the property again. I was asked if I wanted to press charges on [redacted] by officer [redacted] police dept. I declined prosecution. Another Injunction of Harrasment was filed. This time by my wife as she was the person to answer the door on the [redacted] contrary to [redacted] [redacted] testimony. (Please see protection order against [redacted] [redacted] ordered and signed by the honorable Judge [redacted] on [redacted]

[redacted] was allowed to go on and on and on talking about his friend [redacted] among other things, I was hardly able to get in a word without both his on, off, on, and off again attorney and Judge [redacted] stopping me. It was as though [redacted] had two attorney's at times, while I had none.

At times [] was showing the Judge pictures, most of the time without anything being said; [] would just pick them up and show Judge [] Judge [] never stopped him, and never told him to show them to me.

It seemed to me that Judge [] was not impartial at all, in fact, it seemed to me that she was very partial on numerous occasions during the hearing of []

Second, I tried to submitted a motion to limit proceeding to what Defendant had asked for. Specifically, "Modification to possess firearms". A clerk by the name of [] would not allow me to file it with the court. (EXHIBIT 1 Attached)

Third, after discovering that Judge [] had incorrectly entered the date of [] I called the court and left a message on [] the same day of the hearing. To please correct the order with the FACTUAL DATE of [] that the Honorable Judge [] signed and ordered the Injunction.

On [] I physically appeared before the clerk and inquired if the judge order of [] had been corrected. I was told, it had not. I filed motion to correct Court order signed by Judge [] of []

I feel to just change the facts of the case and refuse to correct the error is detereamental in establishing TRUST, and is CONDUCT that brings the Judiciary into Disrepute. In addition, I feel Judge [] has Violated the Code of Judicial Conduct, by displaying Partiality at differant times throughout the hearing.

If anything else is needed by the Commision of Judicial Conduct, or if anything winds up lost or missing like my filed pleadings of [] please contact me and I will provide them to you. To my regret I learned years ago that it is not uncommon for evidence to be lost in [] Courts.

I thank your commision for being in place and like to believe it will be extremely vaLUABLE in preventing some Judges from doing whatever they want. More importantly it could be a huge asset in preventing, or at least limiting CORRUPTION within the Arizona Court system.
