On [redacted] at approximately 10am I went to court on a "summons and complaint detainer" of Case No. [redacted] whereby it seems that someone was tampering with such document to mislead the defendant, [redacted] concerning the proper date to be in court. See attached document of evidence whereby someone manually marked over the number "22" with a "4" manually. The "4" has no signature above the number "2" or Manuel #4. Also there is no attempt to change the word "Tuesday" to "Thursday". [redacted] filed a "motion to dismiss" on such grounds with the Honorable, [redacted] residing, [redacted] denied such request for "motion of dismissal".

On [redacted] at approximately 10am [redacted] told [redacted] that he had 20 minutes to prepare to defend his case after [redacted] requested motion for an attorney, but was denied counsel by Honorable, [redacted] said to [redacted] "we'll take care of it outside".

[redacted] was duped into signing document of "stipulation forcible detainer" by the well experienced attorney of [redacted] by the name of [redacted] [redacted] lost his apartment due to the ethics, prejudice and biased behavior of [redacted] [redacted] told [redacted] that he was interested in keeping his section-8 voucher. [redacted] said that by signing the stipulated forcible detainer should save his section-8 voucher.

[redacted] filed a complaint of ethical behavior of [redacted] with the State Bar of Arizona and the inquiry number is [redacted] [redacted] is also trying to get the audio tapes of such unethical proceedings or hearing in which [redacted] resided over.
