The commission is not an appellate court and cannot change a judge's decisions; therefore, the complaint is dismissed pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

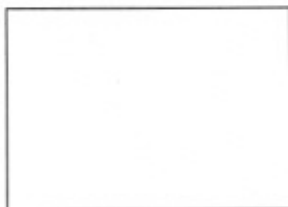

To Whom It May Concern:

I appeared before the Honorable on in the Justice Court in a matter involving a dispute between me and my former tenants concerning unpaid rent and damage to the premises. Although I believe Judge was substantially biased in his ruling against me, this complaint does not take issue with the ruling, but rather with an error in Judge written ruling that incorrectly resulted in a net judgment against me.

Undisputed was the fact that the owed per month throughout their tenancy, including through when they finally moved. However, when preparing his written judgment, Judge failed to include the rent plus the additional five days in This mistake in the judgment resulted in me being incorrectly designated as the judgment debtor owing when in fact the owe me after deducting the rent from their security deposit of

I have written numerous times to Judge asking him to correct the mistake in the judgment to reflect the proper findings of the court. He has not responded to any of my written requests nor has he issued a corrected judgment. Enclosed for your reference is a copy of the judgment and my correspondence to Judge

In a last attempt to avoid further expensive litigation in a higher court to require Judge compliance, I would ask the Commission's assistance in obtaining Judge cooperation in correcting his judgment in this matter.
