THE JUDGE WAS EXTREMELY HOSTILE TO ME. THE HOSTILITY'S BEGAN IN THE FIRST FEW MINUTES OF THE TRIAL, AND CONTINUED THROUGHOUT. IN MY OPINION

HIS HOSTILITY'S WERE BOTH INTIMIDATING AND THREATINING, AND MADE IT VERY DIFFICULT FOR ME TO TESTIFY, WHICH IN TURN HURT MY CASE. THIS WAS

WITNESSED BY EVERYONE IN THE COURTROOM INCLUDING MY 4 WITNESSES WHO IN TURN WERE SCARED OF THE JUDGE. THE JUDGE WAS EVIDENTLY ANGRY ABOUT SOMETHING THAT HAPPENED BEFORE THE TRIAL BEGAN, AND ATTACKED VERBALLY AND WITH FINGER POINTING THE PLAINTIFF. OBVIOUSLY AT CONCLUSION THE JUDGE RULED AGAINST THE PLAINTIFF.

ABOUT 18 MONTHS AGO I VIEWED A TELEVISION PROGRAM ON A LOCAL PHOENIX, AZ. STATION, THAT INTERVIEWED JUDGE'S FROM THE COMMISSION ON JUDICIAL CONDUCT.

THE JUDGE'S DESCRIBED THE PURPOSE OF THE JUDICIAL COMMISSION AND ENCOURAGED PEOPLE TO NOTIFY THE COMMISSION IF THEY FELT THAT A JUDGE WAS IMPROPER IN HIS OR HER BEHAVIOR. THE COMMISSION JUDGE'S ALSO SAID THAT IF NECESSARY THEY WOULD MEET WITH THE COMPLAINANT. JUDGE

ARIZONA, JUSTICE COURT HAD A GRUDGE AGAINST THE PLAINTIFF BEFORE THE TRIAL STARTED. THE WITNESSES EQUALLY FELT EQUALLY FEARFULL OF THE JUDGE WHICH IN TURN IMPAIRED THEIR ABILITY TO TESTIFY.
