accuse Judge [redacted] of knowingly,

1. Subverting the law.
2. Subversion of the law.
3. Subordination of perjury.
4. Allowing false documents to be introduced into evidence.
5. Allowing Attorney [redacted] to attempt to use the law to steal my legal interest in my marital home.

1. Attorney [redacted] had my ill wife whom had [redacted] lie under oath. See petition for dissolution of marriage, page 2 - line 2 "respondent is presently employed as [redacted] At the time this statement was made I had no job at all. This statement was false and under oath. This was done in judge [redacted] Court.

2. See attached letter from my ex-wifes father pertaining to our house and my wife's car. See CD of hearing [redacted]

3. Judge [redacted] knowingly allowed perjured statements to be made by Attorney [redacted] and my wife, in his courtroom and did nothing about it. Also see CD of court records [redacted] Also see letter from father dated [redacted] See wives affidavit of financial information page #3 and page #10. You will see money received from her father were loans.

4. Of his own volition, Judge [redacted] awarded all of the contents of our house, which was community property to my wife, without my permission or consent. Therefore, I accuse Judge [redacted] of knowingly using the law to steal from me what was rightfully mine under the law and taking advantage of the handicapped!

5. Judge [redacted] allowed all of these illegal acts to take place in his court room, and because he and [redacted] did all of these illegal things, both Judge [redacted] and [redacted] have caused my family and myself irreparable harm.

6. I accuse Judge [redacted] of allowing false documents to be introduced into evidence as proof of false statement. See letter form my ex-wife's father. Which was introduced as proof that her car was bought with money that was gifted to her. See petition for dissolution of marriage. Page 2 line 2, this statement is false and was accepted by the court as true. I accuse Judge [redacted] of conspiring to break the law and of violating my rights under the law. Because of his actions, real harm was done to me and my family. Therefore I request redress and reparations for all harm done.

7. I claim that Judge [redacted] knowingly allowed these fraudulent acts to take place in his court room.
