My motion as accepted by Judge [redacted] to shorten time due to economic hardship was not respected by Judge [redacted] (Judge [redacted] later recused); Judge [redacted] did not respect the correct order of hearing the case - even though I brought the case to probate he attempted to have the law firm heard first; I was clearly NOT informed of subsequent hearing scheduled before the next hearing scheduled in court before Judge [redacted] thus the case was adjudicated without me being informed of a hearing and at that hearing court costs were awarded AND the hearing scheduled before Judge [redacted] and Attorney [redacted] was wrongly vacated AND I was not informed of this correctly; my motions brought before the court, with citations supporting, were very wrongly not correctly addressed, including the such utterly obvious corrections to minute entries addressing my father as "an adult" instead of the decedent in this objection to the original probate of my father's will. Cruel and needless inhumanity + misadministration - loss of abilities.

Furthermore, as the only son of [redacted] and a long time and continuous dependant of their estate, my various objections to the original probate were clear and true and utterly obviously within the jurisdiction of the court - I was not informed of the original probate as required by law. The court did not address wrongful procedure and clear contempt by Attorney [redacted] by not accepting documents from me in court after stating he had not received them. This case is a heinous, evil, prejudiced and racist ignoring of justice, rules and procedure to favor attorneys defrauding the elderly and the estate of a dependant. [redacted] has been utterly incompetent.
