I am baffled at how liberal Judge [Redacted] has been when making decisions regarding my children and [Redacted] [Redacted] an order was written by Judge [Redacted]. Prior to this, he ordered [Redacted] and I, [Redacted], to see a state appointed conciliation officer. wherein [Redacted] was ordered to take a drug test, which he failed. Her report has [Redacted] as a coniver, very dishonest, and not to be given any more time with my children. Judge [Redacted] even had [Redacted] take a drug test. Once again, he failed it. Judge [Redacted] wrote in his minutes, "Positive/Diluted/ Missed Test.... finding is contrary to the best interest of a child." (page, "G") Yet, Judge [Redacted] cut my child support by [Redacted] and gave [Redacted] more time with [Redacted]. My children are being "walked on by" [Redacted].

Judge [Redacted] ordered [Redacted] to take two drug tests a month. I was sent copies. Missed tests, diluted, and positive; yet, Judge [Redacted] who received all these tests never took action. I was shocked, so I called TASC and requested a six month report be sent to Judge [Redacted]. I filed an objection to his order listing the lies I had proof of which were written; therefore hoping it to be rewritten. It was not. Since this, I have received ^{copies at} positive drug tests from TASC for [Redacted]. The personal safety and well being of my children is being ignored by Judge [Redacted]. After my objection was basically lauded at, I requested an e- (Attach additional sheets as needed) merge or change/ modification of order [Redacted]. Once again, Judge →

[redacted] did not grant. I then filed an order of protection for my children, [redacted] and [redacted] to protect them from their father. [redacted] Police, officer [redacted] was called by [redacted] in order to corner me. I will not let [redacted] see [redacted]. After seeing the evidence I have, officer [redacted] was even shocked at the lack of responsibility Judge [redacted] has shown toward my children on [redacted] their behalf.
