Until  when I went to court I was not sure what the ~~alleged~~ alleged infraction entailed. It was on that morning that  showed me my photo taken by another officer.  issued a ticket and according to testimony was responsible for sending it (I never received it).  was the issuing officer but was not there the day of the alleged violation. The officer who actually was responsible for giving me the ticket did not show up for court. As I have stated I still have not received a ticket, but was found guilty of speeding. I was not given an opportunity to question the officer responsible for the ticket, nor was I given an opportunity to question the technician(s). In addition, according to testimony  although responsible for sending the ticket, ~~was~~ saved it. He could offer no proof (evidence) that it was sent or I ever received it.

I am not a Harvard Graduate and without the proper witnesses for the state present I did not have enough time to prepare or if necessary, as the Sgt stated Superior the people who shall have been there.

Judge [Redacted] seems to convict people if they show up to court. He does not seem to listen to the testimony. The State does not have a case. A representative of the city showed up, (not the officer responsible for giving the citation), the technician responsible for calibrating did not show up, and the person for sewing the ticket did not show up. Judge [Redacted] seems to think that is OK. It does not matter to Judge [Redacted] that I was not given a citation nor a fair trial. Judge [Redacted] based his decision totally on hearsay without giving me an opportunity to question my accusers. I personally think and hopefully, you will agree that Judge [Redacted] brings the judiciary in disrepute evidenced by this case.
