On I was issued a summons to appear with an order to show cause. This order was signed by the judge. This is counter to the separation of powers as outlined by Article 5 sec 4 and Article 6 sec 1 of the Arizona Constitution. Further the court has not attempted to obtain the jurisdiction as per ARS 13-121 which clearly and in plain language states the court shall have jurisdiction only after due proof of notice has been made to Arizona Attorney General's Office.

Knowing that the court lacked jurisdiction and I believe would never have jurisdiction I retained attorney to detail the error in procedure by this court. I have enclosed the portions of memo that pertain to these issues. I further understand that due to the fact that I received a one year suspended sentence for which a mandate was issued by the Court of Appeals on that I am not even any longer eligible to have sentence imposed.

response to the statutes and constitution was that it was to much work for him and he had been doing things the other (wrong) way through his regime as JP. is defying the statutes and laws that tell him he has no jurisdiction. Statute 13-121 was put into place to stop just such behavior.

by these courts but [redacted] refuse to follow the statutes dictates, [redacted] also suggested that this statute does not apply to his court even though it clearly and specifically applies to his court, the trial court.

In that [redacted] has indicated that he has persistently refused to follow procedure I believe Advisory Opinion 92-10 (attached) applies to [redacted] behavior.

Items 2, 3 and 4 apply to my case and his comment that that was the procedure he had followed encompasses item one.

To summarize my situation I have been ordered out of my home under the threat of force to face a court with no jurisdiction. This court's stated intent is to take my liberty without jurisdiction to do so only the threat of force against myself. Never did I think I would hear of such a thing in this country much less be the target of such illegal behavior by the court. In that the judge is already operating outside of the limits of the threat of force

I believe that the taking of one's
liberty by a court with no jurisdiction is
as egregious as the courts behavior could
possibly be. For this reason I am asking
that the commission department at least call
or write this judge to tell him you
have received this complaint and that
the court obviously has no jurisdiction.
