JUDICIAL CANNON 3(B)(B) A JUDGE SHALL DISPOSE OF ALL JUDICIAL  
MATTERS PROMPTLY, EFFICIENTLY AND FAIRLY. ALSO CANNON 2(A)  
A JUDGE SHALL RESPECT AND COMPLY WITH THE LAW AND SHALL ACT AT ALL  
TIMES IN A MANNER THAT PROMOTES PUBLIC CONFIDENCE IN THE INTEGRITY  
AND IMPARTIALITY OF THE JUDICIARY. JUDGE [REDACTED] HEARD TESTIMONY  
FROM THE MEDICAL DOCTOR "WITHOUT" PRODUCING A TRANSCRIPT TO  
PRESERVE MY ISSUE. THE DOCTOR TESTIFIED THAT UPON HEARING  
THAT I SIGNED A PLEA BARGAIN, THAT THE DOCTOR HAD PRESCRIBED  
TO ME MEDICATION THAT WOULD IN FACT AFFECT MY MENTAL ABILITY  
TO MAKE DECISIONS. THE DOCTOR FURTHER TESTIFIED THAT I SHOULD  
NOT HAVE BEEN ALLOWED TO SIGN A PLEA WHILE TAKING THIS  
MEDICATION. THE JUDGE MADE A DECISION TO "ACCEPT" MY PLEA.  
THE JUDGE FAILED TO TAKE THIS ISSUE INTO ACCOUNT. I  
DO NOT WANT TO ACCEPT THIS PLEA BUT THE JUDGE AND  
THE ATTORNEY DISREGARDED MY ISSUES AND THE DOCTOR'S CONCERN.  
ATTACHED ARE THE FOLLOWING CORRESPONDENCE TO MY ATTORNEY. MY ATTORNEY  
HAS ASKED ME TO ADDRESS THIS ALSO TO THE JUDGE. THANK YOU FOR YOUR TIME.
