I observed an obstruction of justice to a fair trial when my questions were not answered by the judge, my witness was not allowed to testify on my behalf. Therefore, I am totally denied Constitutional and Civil Liberties.

I declare accountability for obstruction of justice by Judge James T. Blomo also denying me the appeal-process of the due-process. I have certainly served my dues for expressing the first amendment of the Constitution of the U.S., freedom of Speech by being incarcerated for it.

Along with the due-process, there is an appeal-process. I, Kirk Watson am denied equal justice under law, an undertone of treason against the very sanctity of the foundation of the U.S.A. and negating my sovereignty rights as a U.S. citizen, an abomination to my inalienable rights.
