I ask that you review the audio from both trial dates of _____ and _____ and you will hear clearly where _____ approaches Judge _____ and hands her a sealed envelope, not to be opened or handled by opposing counsel and client nor anyone else pertaining to the case. Judge _____ accepts the sealed envelope, against opposing council's objections, and advises her staff to submit it as evidence in the case.
