COMPLAINT AGAINST A JUDGE

I discharged my Attorney and Filed a Motion for Self-Representation. At the hearing on my motion the Judge was visibly angry and hostile toward me. The tone was contemptuous. Her questions were asked in a hostile and intemperant manner. Her gaze was hostile and demeanor disgusted. I was scolded for not listening to her questions when I gave an answer that did not please her. I felt intimidated, scorned and ridiculed and embarrassed in front of the entire Court Room. She was clearly angry that I had chosen to exercise my 5th amendment rights and act as my own Attorney. She was more concerned with the Court calendar than protecting my rights as a citizen, probably accused of a crime. I felt disrespected and belittled. I was not treated with dignity or respect. But worse I feel she was sending a message that I will be punished for troubling the Court by asking for a trial. The bias against me was palpable. My rights are not being protected.
