I would like to file a Complaint against Judge

Arizona.

On [redacted] dismissed my cases on the basis that the Defendants were not served, even though the case file reflected that the Defendants had been served (notified) by the Court itself. I was scheduled for a 1:00 p.m. hearing and sat through an entire afternoon of solely Hispanic Plaintiffs, witnesses and defendants for other cases. The only other Anglo people on the docket for that day were scheduled for 3:00 p.m. and they gave up and left the court.

When I was finally allowed to come forward for my case around 4:30 p.m., Judge [redacted] immediately dismissed my cases against my two Hispanic defendants, [redacted] who were present. If the Hispanic defendants had not been served, how would they have known to show up in Court that day for the hearings? I was the only Anglo person in the Court that afternoon, and Judge [redacted] acted with racial prejudice against me and unlawfully dismissed my cases due to lack of service even though the Defendants had been served by the Court itself. He also refused to hear my cases in the future and referred me to another Judge.
