



## Complaint against Judge

Date: February 19, 2008

On Pro-Tem Judge had parked his personal vehicle in the Constable's reserved parking space at . The space is clearly marked with a sign which reads "Reserved for Constables and Marked Police Vehicles Only".

I latter contacted at Judge Office and advised him that he was parked in the Constable designated parking space. told me that he parked there because he did not want to park in the additional court parking area because he did not have an access card to the side door. moved his vehicle after I asked him to do so.

Latter this same day I was exiting the court building when I observed parked in the Constable designated parking area. I was able to contact the owner of the Her name was and she was a private process server. I asked her to move her vehicle as it was parked in a designated parking space reserved for Constables. explained to me that Judge had given her permission to park in the Constable designated parking area. Court staff was present during this conversation. I told that if there were any complaints about this issue Judge should contact I explained to that her vehicle was subject to towing if it were not moved. moved her vehicle as requested.

On Tuesday, I noticed and Judge having a conversation by the security window at the court. At this time Judge looked in my direction and motioned for me to step over to where he and were standing.

Judge raised his voice at me in the presence of and several court staff members. He told me that he had given permission to park in the Constable designated parking area and that *she was the only one that he had given permission to.*

I then explained to Judge that those parking spaces are clearly marked and designated for Constables and marked police vehicles. Judge then looked at and told her that it was okay to continue parking in the designated areas. I then explained to that if she continued to disregard my request, her vehicle would be towed. Judge then stated to me that "you are only a deputy constable". I replied that I was a peace officer who can issue citations, arrest and have vehicles towed. Judge then with a raised voice stated to me "*let's see you give me a ticket when I go park my vehicle in the constable parking space*". Judge then walked away waving his hands and arms.
