I supposedly got arrested at  
for a 3rd degree trespass.  
I went on TV Court and Judge \_\_\_\_\_ presided.  
Judge \_\_\_\_\_ set my Arraignment Date for Friday  
I went to my Arraignment on TV. Judge \_\_\_\_\_ was  
presiding. The first thing Judge \_\_\_\_\_ said, "Mr. \_\_\_\_\_, you have been  
in my Court numerous times. The last time I saw you, I told you I would give  
you some time. At this time, either you plead I am holding you until you see  
the prosecutor and see what they recommend,  
I saw Judge \_\_\_\_\_ releasing men and women on similar or serious charges  
that day. Then, while detained I saw and heard Judge \_\_\_\_\_ releasing  
men and women who have been in her court numerous times. I feel Judge  
is bias and prejudice against certain minorities.  
I went to a Pretrial Conference hearing on another matter, I saw  
Judge \_\_\_\_\_ again, this time in person. She sentenced me to 60 days with 30  
days suspended on CR \_\_\_\_\_ with 7 days back time. At the same CR  
is to run concurrent with this case. I asked Judge \_\_\_\_\_ "I did 18 days  
on CR \_\_\_\_\_ "She said, "I can't give you a sentence one that is more, the  
other one less, both sentences start today." Eighteen days I spent incarcerated  
on CR \_\_\_\_\_ wasn't given back to me. This is in violation of Arizona Revised Statute  
where days spend incarcerated are given back on all allegations.

- 1) Holding an accused on a lowest misdemeanor is Cruel & Unusual Punishment.
- 2) Not giving an accused the days he/she spend incarcerated isn't right.
- 3) Not treating an accused fairly is bias and prejudicial.
- 4) Acting in impropriety on Time incarcerated isn't right.
- 5) Releasing or fining people with same charges is improper.
