defendants.

After pronouncing sentence (which is her job) she engaged  
in a verbal character attack, calling the defendant a  
"liar" and a "thief" and other derogatory comments. She  
apparently gave no regard to the fact that when the  
offenses were committed the defendant suffered  
from an undiagnosed Serious Mental Illness (This  
was all in evidence.)

This assault showed complete disregard and  
disrespect for the defendant's disability. This  
violates 3B(5) of the Code.

This also was neither "dignified" or "courteous"  
and therefore 3B(4) of the Code.

I was humiliated and shamed in front of family  
and friends.

I am attempting to obtain court transcripts, which are being  
held by my appellate counsel
