Judge ignored ARS-25-320 by ordering me to pay what was CLEARLY the petitioner's amount, NOT MINE! Due to his error of judgment my truck was repossessed, I have been bringing home \$1374 per week having to claim max. exemptions, and seek state assistance. I have 5 children to support; he completely ignored ARS-25-320 D "the financial resources + needs of the non-custodial parent."

Judge ignored + allowed the petitioner to deduct \$800 per month childcare costs, with only 2 checks that were several weeks apart, this is in complete opposition to the Child Support Guidelines which states: If these costs vary throughout the year, add the amounts for each month together and divide by 12 to annualize the cost.

This matter was clearly not handled correctly and I am fully aware that this is a lawsuit matter.
