Committed the following violations of the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct

- (1) did not comply with the law, A.R.S. § 22-214, requiring a justice of the peace to "issue forthwith a summons to defendant" before proceeding against  
(Canons 2A & 3A)
- (2) intentionally brought the judiciary into disrepute by relying upon criminal arrest statute A.R.S. § 13-3903(D) with knowledge that the record was absent of a criminal citation against and absent of an arrest of  
before a judicial officer.  
(Canons 1A & 2A)
- (3) did not act in a manner that promotes public confidence nor did he display competence in the law when he misquoted the plain language of A.R.S. § 13-3903(D) in open court.  
(Canons 2(A) & 3(B)2)
- (4) misled that a civil traffic hearing date would be set and had been set, but did not provide notice of the alleged hearing date to In fact a future hearing date was not entered into the record. (Canons 3B(9)(10) & 2A & 3A)
