I did appear to court on [redacted] when I should have it was a waste of time he's charging \$149.00 for court fees and also he was telling the plaintiff if he wanted to get reimbursed for his loss of wages for that day to file a motion. I think it should be the other way around the ^{COURT} should pay my gas and wasting my time, that's one of the reasons we have a court date on [redacted] and I did everything they told me to do! so it was a waste of time having a court date at [redacted]. I don't have time for this! if a judge could stop wasting my time for now reason at all I would really appreciate this! I notice his conduct with me is very rude to me and with the other people he is not like that maybe because I'm hispanic or if he has something personal towards I don't know? If you could please take the time to investigate this matter I would appreciate it!

As far as I know I see this a racist issue.
