COMPLAINT AGAINST A JUDGE

This court has, for nearly four (4) years, continued to issue warrants for my arrest knowing full well that I was (and am) in prison and cannot come to court dates. This practice began while Judge _____ was presiding. I met with Judge _____ He would not reverse the fees. I paid \$180.00 or more. I was ordered to attend counseling by Judge _____. I re-offended and was sent back to prison. I received five (5) years. Judge _____ issued a warrant. I saw Judge _____ at video court. He advised me that he knows I'm in prison, but that he's going to continue issuing warrants and demanding that I go to Justice Services, Inc for counseling. He made me sign a paper stating that I'd go to counseling in 48 hours, or another warrant would be issued. I advised him I was serving five years and that a warrant would adversely affect my classification and ability to engage in certain rehabilitative programs. He said, "That's exactly right. You should've thought about that before you missed counseling classes, I'm going to issue the warrant right away." A letter was just sent to my former address saying I owed \$90.00 in warrant fees, or another warrant would issue. The court knows I'm not at that address, that I'm in prison. It's on the record (along with the above quote) _____ These demands, warrant fees, and comments by Judge _____, are vindictive and not in the spirit of justice. I am being hounded and bullied by the court. They will not even acknowledge or respond to my written appeal (attached herein).
