Again Hon. allowed his bias and prejudice to interfere with his ability to perform his judicial duties in a just and proper manner. When the attorney requested to reschedule the hearing, he granted her request. When the attorney requested to reschedule the hearing, the judge denied it; even though the reason my attorney had a scheduled conflict due as a direct result of the judge approving opposing counsel's reschedule request.
