I was arrested on a felony no-bond warrent
 After going before honorable judge in
 ,az the judge questioned me about the charges
 and lowered it from felony to a misdemeanor gave me a bond of
 1000 dollars with a promise to appear in the county court
 on . I posted bond and appeared as promised, But
 failed to appear for my arraignment, I drove 400 miles
 round trip. I and my witness talked with 2 sheriffs officers
 I was told they thought I bonded out to fast. I tried filing
 charges once again against my wife for lying on the order of
 protection and the divorce papers after sending me to the coast
 1500 miles away, so she could steal 2 vehicles, cash, and lots
 of my personal items. I was not allowed to file, so my witness
 and I went back to and we kept in touch with local
 authorities, there was no warrent for ^{ME} anywhere in the world for
 my arrest up to one and a half months later. So I went back to
 the area to file civil suit against my wife, but I was
 arrested on the same charges, it seems a warrent has magically
 appeared dated one day after failed to appear for my
 arraignment out of judge court. I was held for
 10 months without a trial and forced to sign a plea bargain
 or I would spend 4-5 months longer incarcerated. the county
 attorney lied to the court about my status and
 also contaminating my ^(Attach additional sheets as needed) rule 11 saying I was an meth. and with
 no evidence of the trumped up charges, the judge allowed me to
 remain incarcerated 303 even though I had posted bond and was
 not a flight risk, I lost my livelyhood, I am more than pist off.
