COMPLAINT AGAINST A JUDGE

The first incident occurred when I was not notified of my original preliminary protective conference. I met with a child protective services case worker and was told they had court on that day and it was vacated because I did not show up. It was rescheduled, ~~and when I appeared~~ before the new hearing I went for a visit with my daughter and found that she had been injured while in their custody. All of her hair had been cut and ~~her~~ her health had declined. I appeared at the new hearing and was punished against by Child Protective Services and had my ~~attorney~~ legal defender not assert and the judge did not hear my reply or evidence. I then asked for a new legal defender because my then legal defender proceeded to argue with me and state that he might not want to represent me. I filed a motion then on and still do not have a new legal defender and no one advocating for me and my daughter. I also stated in the motion that the matter was urgent due to *(Attach additional sheets as needed)* my daughter being injured while in the custody of child protective services. I have also been receiving my mailings late or not at all. For the last appearance I had a phone call which was fine. However my daughter's safety is still a concern.
