1. On January 7, 2009, I appeared before Judge _____ in Case No. _____ concerning child support arrears.
2. Judge _____ found me in contempt of court even though I offered to bring in receipts showing that child support was paid for November, 2008. There was an order of assignment taking the monies out of my paycheck, but my employer was not complying. During the hearing, she continually rolled her eyes at me.
3. I was subsequently arrested by the Maricopa County Sheriff and had to post a cash bond of \$ 600.00. I was then fired from my job for missing work.
4. On November 10, 2008, Judge _____ released my address to the public, which was protected. (See attached Minute Entry.)

OPINIONS OF _____ TO JUDICIAL MISCONDUCT COMMISSION

1. I believe that Judge _____ should recuse herself from this case and send it back to Judge _____, who previously heard the case and knows the facts of the case.
2. I believe that Judge _____ is stupid, ignorant, and does not know what she is talking about.
3. I believe that Judge _____ needs more training and that she should be demoted to a Commissioner or removed from the bench.
4. I believe that Judge _____'s releasing of my address put the lives of myself, my wife, and my children in danger.

RECOMMENDATIONS OF _____

1. Judge _____ should be given more training on Family Court matters.
2. She should be suspended for ten days without pay and attend training during that period.
