But still I was arrested, by officer for disorderly conduct for spilling mustard, root beer, soda, and grape jelly on my floor as my part in what the law states and considers to be domestic violence, I explained to about my current health issues, disabilities, medications ect. When I attended video court at the County Jail Judge ordered that I do not go back to my home and that I contact police to pick up my belongings and not return. Obviously, either TPD did not inform or overlooked or failed to take into consideration the health risks involved, by leaving me homeless with no place to go as I am disabled, while my wifes health is excellent with the exact same charges gets, to go home in the warm while I am out in the cold a sick man. Ruling was extremely inhumane and evil. I will also file a complaint about this matter to the (Arizona Department of health) and all agencies attached, and any agency or departments that fail to fully investigate this matter will be reported to the (governors office) and all the proper channels.
