This judge is biased against disabled citizens. This judge issued an order which violated the 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment right of due to bigotry, anti-disabled citizens, and discrimination against and Americans with disabilities. Moreover, the judge maliciously interfered with vocational rehabilitation plan by issuing an order in violation of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment.

This judge should be held accountable and all monies Betramale could have earned from his vocational rehabilitation process should be deducted from her pay. An anti-disabled judge such as \_\_\_\_\_ should be removed from the bench due to her issuance of anti-disabled rulings violating the Second Amendment of disabled citizens which have the effect of denying equal protection, the ability to defend himself against violent crime, and ultimately increase tax dollars and weaken the economy by denying employment opportunities and the achievement of State sponsored, DCS approved vocational rehabilitation Plan.

This judge must remove Betramale from NICJ and vacate any ruling infringing upon his 2<sup>nd</sup> Amendment rights and apologize for her discriminatory ruling against disabled Americans.

In sum, her rulings increase tax dollars, delay employment of disabled citizens, increase the risk of disabled becoming victims of violence, violate the constitution, are bigoted and Un-American.
