I have obeyed that judgement and it has been over 6 month from the day. He has Rule 11ed me and the Attorney 1st of has sent the notification to the address I was ordered to stay outside one mile. The rest of the time I have not been able to contact or talk to him since that day about the Rule 11 to find out about the time and date I was intended to visit with the evaluator. I asked that the charges be dismissed and pled not guilty and he has been rather angry and upset since then. I particularly with me. I would like to reiterate that it has been 6 month that this case has dragged on.
