On Friday, June 12, 2009, 1:30 PM, Court with a young girl entered the approximately 7 – 8 yrs old. was instructed to remove all metal objects from his person. Upon placing all metal objects near metal detector, Officer Pro Tem Identification Badge. Upon observed a observing the Pro Tem Badge, Officer instructed to proceed through the metal detector. After the detector sounded, Officer instructed him to remove his belt. became irate upon being instructed to remove his belt and questioned why Officer would allow him to enter without removing his belt and Officer would not. Officer stated that it was Judge ruling that everyone remove their belt and we do not honor ID Badges.

stated that Judge was an idiot! Officer stepped to the window in the doorway of the Security Area and said to "who are you calling an idiot"? repeated "Judge ". Officer then told if he felt like calling Judge an idiot, then he should go in person. then told Officer that he would do just that. Officer told that would be fine but he should refrain from doing that in the presence of Security Officers. Officer advised that if he continued to say that, "What is your name" (in an angry he would be asked to leave the building. Then said to Officer voice). Officer pointed to his ID tag and said "my name is ". Officer responded "what is your name"? responded "my name is Judge and I'm going to get you"! Officer responded "well you do that". then left the Security Area.
