To the best of Complainant's knowledge and belief, Judge [redacted] is personal friends with Petitioner's mother, thereby purposely and maliciously dragging out his rulings to punish Complainant, benefiting opposing party. Judge [redacted] unethical/impropriety allowed his affiliations to influence his waffling and Criminal Actions for lack of legally complying with Ruling of Cases within the 60 Day Time frame. Canon 2; Rules of the Supreme Court.

Judge [redacted] not only violated the 60 Day Time Frame attached to Complainant's January 8th, 2009 Trial, and previous unrelated pleadings, but has used his judicial power for emotional abuse, creating the appearance of impropriety.

Therefore, Complainant requests Judge [redacted] immediate resignation from judicial office, with appropriate sanctions barring him from holding judicial office in Arizona.
