Dear Commission on Judicial Conduct,

I recently appeared in front of Arizona Superior Court, Maricopa County, Judge on June 21st, 2009 for a settlement conference. At the settlement conference I believe Judge was wrong for not letting me change lawyers. I believe this was inappropriate. I asked for a new lawyer because Attorney was misrepresenting me. I have since filed a complaint with AZ State Bar inquiring into ~~poor~~ Conduct.

Judge did not allow me to terminate Atty and appoint new counsel, this bummed me out.

Attorney Continues to misrepresent me at Sentencing by not abiding by my communicated objectives, written and spoken, of requesting 5yrs. from Honorable Judge at the time of Sentencing, which I believe hurt my chances for getting a more reasonable sentence.

I feel hurt, lost, and disappointed that I tried to get a different lawyer because she was ineffective and the judge wouldn't let me. and she continued to not abide by my reasonable requests or diligently defend me. Along with other ~~misdeeds~~ Atty requested 7.5 yrs. That is only 6 months less than what the state recommended of 8yrs. I would of liked 5yrs and even that's a long time.

I don't know what to do about getting something done about my sentence. What can I do?

I believe Judge and Attorney both may have been hurtful to my case by there actions or lack of.

Dear Commission on Judicial Conduct,

I went in front of Judge _____ in June of 2009 on
approximately the 23rd day and I believe that the
Judge acted inappropriately and I felt threatened by
him. I felt threatened and intimidated by Judge
_____ on June 23rd, 2009 at my Pretrial Conference,
CR _____, when he said he wasn't playing
with me. I was a pretrial Defendant who had not
been convicted of the offense charged and feared for
my life, liberty, and punishment by Judge _____
because I would not sign the plea and then
he said that "he wasn't playing with me". I took
that as a threat and that there would be
consequences by him if I didn't do what he

3500 $\frac{1}{2}$ sign the plea. I was a pre-trial defendant that had a right to be treated with respect and a I had a right not to sign a plea if I didn't want to. After that I told the judge I felt threatened by him because he would not let me reject the plea. I believe this was all on the record and the commission could, if it wanted to, review the transcripts. I believe the judge threatened me when he said he wasn't "playing with me", a pre-trial defendant. I do not consider my life, liberty, or ease a game. There is nothing I did that justifies the judge threatening me. This letter is also to advise you of my current address. I sent a previous letter to the commission on approximately July 24th, 2009.
