On 12/18/08 I filed for a modification of parenting time due to ongoing moves without notification while our son was in his care. One of which was living in a tent on a Christmas tree lot. I also filed for an Enforcement order which has been an ongoing problem for 10+ years. On 3/9/09 at our hearing I was explaining to the Judge that even more information had come out through counseling that father was speaking to him about things that were affecting his emotional well being like I was making him pay me \$400 per month for him to see, I was trying to put him in jail, I was trying to keep him from seeing, etc. He asked if he was aware that I was in counseling + he said yes + asked if he participated + he said no + the judge told him that wasn't very wise. Then he asked me what he wanted him to do about it. I was floored. I brought up the fact that he had moved on several occasions without notifying me + there were no address changes but one dated 12/13/08 in the court website showing this. He looked at + denied it + Judge said that we would be going to Conciliation Services + then trial before on June 1st, 2009. Conciliation Services spoke to us, spoke to but made no attempt to speak to his counselor. Judge while stating that he could see that was obviously being coached + I obviously had reason for concern with address changes + no notification, fathers ongoing dishonesty, speaking to about adult issues. Father being behind in support payments, child's adjustment is significantly better at mother's home than at Father's. Court was concerned about overnight living conditions at Father's, but doesn't make any changes. It seems like unless a child has bruises no one cares. Why can't we be proactive + try to prevent things from getting worse when we see the signs in stead of saying "what do you want me to do?" He's violated every order + you all keep letting him. →

I am very aware that the Atty I obtained did more for case than
mine & I am taking that up with the state Bar of Arizona, but it was also
very obvious that Judge could see as did Judge Hemores
w/out notifying the court or me, I don't care other than he does this when
' is visiting him and then won't tell me the address until the last min.
Constantly discusses issues with that should not know about.
An 8 year old shouldn't even know what child support is much less how
much is paid. The fact that he was told a very negative wrong defendant
of what it was was even worse. Telling negative hateful things about the
other parent puts the child in not only an uncomfortable position
but causes ongoing emotional stress that will not stop unless someone
gets involved. I can only do so much w/out your help! I come to you
to get help & get blown off time after time. Then we get ordered
to take classes, fine, I don't mind, I'm taking them, but the
person that needs to is not & what's going to happen? nothing!
At what point do the judges actually uphold the statutes of Arizona
At what point do they help the parent that is trying to help the child?
The children are our future doesn't anyone care anymore?
