② Did not read a motion for reconsideration to allow travel claim to be reinstated and closed it out of hand; crippling case

③ Did not rule on motions to compel discovery against 20+ defendants. Some fully briefed for a previous six months; crippling case.

④ This judge is an insult to the judicial branch of Government and does not take this claim lightly
