I have been into see Judge three times, every single time I have stood in front of her she has talked down to me and has yelled at me. I understand that I am in her court for a reason, because I received a speeding ticket they I owe.

I went into her court room today 7/16/10, because she wanted to see me. I explained that I did not have a job and that I was receiving an employment, but it has stopped for the moment. I told her that I was looking for a job. I could not pay the hundred dollars she wanted me to pay. She told me that was not her problem.

When I was in the court room there were three people ahead of me. one person had a \$3,000.00 fine and she reduced it by \$2,000.00, another person asked her to lower his payments because he didn't have a job and he was going to be looking for one. Another person had fines from years ago and she dismissed his fines and told him he only had to pay the more recent one. All three people

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were from the city of Coolidge. I am not, I live in Queen Creek. She also told them they could mail their payments in. She wrote down on my paperwork that she had to see me for every payment or she would issue a warrant. She called it a review. Both times that we have reviewed I asked her for a lower payment and she said "NO".

I don't have a job or money for gas to be traveling to Coolidge just to review and make the same exact payment \$100.00. My sister has brought me to court the three times and she has to work and go to school. Also, court is at 10:00 in the morning so my sister has to take the day off because she works in Phoenix.

I have no problem paying, but if I had the money, \$100.00 is a whole lot for me right now. I feel she doesn't give me a chance and she is upset with me for no apparent reason.

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My sister has witnessed her act like this both times I had to stand in front of the judge.

She has also said to me what did you say or do to this judge for her to act and treat you how she does. She said I don't think she likes you.

I feel she is not being fair and I don't want special treatment I just want her to be fair.
