ORDER

The complainant alleged that a superior court pro tem judge was biased and engaged in an improper ex parte communication. After analyzing the allegations, the judge's response, and listening to the recording of the hearing, the commission decided to dismiss the complaint with an advisory letter regarding Rule 2.8 of the Code of Judicial Conduct, which requires judges to maintain decorum in court proceedings and to be patient, dignified, and courteous. The commission found no evidence of bias or improper communications. The complaint is dismissed pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.
