ORDER

The complainant alleged that a superior court judge mishandled his case and made unfair rulings because of racial bias. The commission reviewed the allegations and found that the only reason for alleging racial bias was that the complainant and the judge are not of the same race. This is an insufficient basis to support an investigation of the judge's conduct. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.

The purpose of this complaint is to have judge
recue himself from my case as soon as possible because of
his blatant disregard for fairness and equal rights towards
a minority family, military officer and African American
male. A few months ago during a telephonic hearing between
the attorneys and judge he said I should have
my parenting rights restored but in the 23 of July 2010
during a schedule telephonic hearing, my ex-wife's attorney
did not call in so I was told to wait until the 3rd of August
2010 due to the judge's busy court schedule. Now on 3rd August
her attorney was not fined nor was anything mention about
his "no show" for the telephonic hearing on the 23rd of July 2010
and for most of the afternoon judge allow
both attorneys to negotiate, to no positive conclusion
for me. My mother (who is 73 years old) and I did not get
a chance to testify. To date I still do not have
parenting rights! I can only see my girls during
grand parents rights and my ex-wife has not adhere
to those rules to date. Please review this case
file to understand the facts and why this judge
should be removed from my case asap. I know
my family (my girls and I) can be a strong family that
embodies a problem solving culture that we can
act interdependently, appropriately, and positively each day.
Please help us become a family again... Thank you
