The complainant alleged that a justice of the peace misrepresented his credentials on a networking website by incorrectly claiming he serves as a city magistrate. After considering the allegations and reviewing the judge's response, the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct. The judge explained that the error was unintentional and has been corrected. The complaint is dismissed pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.
