The complainant alleged that a superior court judge never gave him his day in court and contends that his case is not closed because he never received the proper "E-file signature" from the judge. The commission reviewed the matter and found no evidence of ethical misconduct on the part of the judge. The electronic minute entries reveal that the court granted a motion to dismiss the case in 2009. Since that time, the court has denied the complainant's repeated attempts to seek reconsideration and to submit additional evidence. The commission is not a court and cannot review or reverse legal rulings. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed in its entirety pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.
