ORDER

The complainant alleged that a justice of the peace was impatient, biased, and he ignored the law regarding notice of service in a forcible entry and detainer case. After reviewing the allegations and listening to the recording of the hearing, the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct on the part of the judge. Whether the judge made the correct determination regarding notice is a legal issue outside the jurisdiction of the commission. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed in its entirety pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.
