**ORDER**

The complainant alleged that a municipal court judge violated his right to a speedy trial and caused him to lose time from work by failing to timely notify him that his hearing was continued.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judge engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

After reviewing the information provided by the complainant and the electronic history of the case, the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct and concluded that the judge did not violate the Code in this case. Whether the complainant received timely notice of a continuance is not evidence that the judge engaged in ethical misconduct. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed in its entirety pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.
