**ORDER**

The complainant alleged that an inept and unfocused justice of the peace mishandled her criminal case.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judge engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

After reviewing the information provided by the complainant, the commission dismissed the complaint because no judge was identified and no act of ethical misconduct was alleged. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed in its entirety pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.
