**ORDER**

The complainant alleged that a superior court judge and a court commissioner violated his legal rights.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judge and commissioner engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

After reviewing the information provided by the complainant along with the electronic records of the complainant's former and current cases, the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct and concluded that neither the judge nor the commissioner violated the Code in this case. The commission does not have jurisdiction to review the legal sufficiency of the judicial officers' rulings. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed in its entirety pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.
