ORDER

The complainant alleged a superior court judge violated his constitutional rights by improperly using his brother's motion to change counsel against him and by denying his motions for a hearing to impeach state witnesses and to sever various counts for a separate trial.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the judge engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

After reviewing the information provided by the complainant and the electronic court records in the case, the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct and concluded that the judge did not violate the Code in this case. The commission does not have jurisdiction to review the legal sufficiency of the judge's rulings. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed in its entirety pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.

MY RIGHTS DURING MY TRIAL AND I WOULD LIKE A FAIR TRIAL.
PLEASE TAKE ACTION UPON THIS COMPLAINT IN TIMELY MANNER AND
I WOULD LIKE A COMPLETE WRITTEN REPORT BACK TO ME
WITH THE NAME OF THE BONDING COMPANY THE JUDGE IS BONDED
WITH AND THE BOND NUMBER AS I HAVE REQUESTED.
