ORDER

The complainant alleged a superior court commissioner violated his constitutional rights by allowing other defendants to proceed before him and ask all the questions they wanted, but did not afford him the same opportunity. He further alleged the commissioner would not allow him to sign a waiver of extradition, and she limited his appearance before her to less than two minutes.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the commissioner engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

After reviewing the information provided by the complainant and the electronic court records, the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct and concluded that the commissioner did not violate the Code in this case. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed in its entirety, pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.
