**ORDER**

The complainant alleged a state administrative law judge and a superior court commissioner made erroneous rulings that adversely affected her legal interests.

The responsibility of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine if the commissioner engaged in conduct that violated the provisions of Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution or the Code of Judicial Conduct and, if so, to take appropriate disciplinary action. The purpose and authority of the commission is limited to this mission.

After reviewing all of the information provided by the complaint, the commission found no evidence of ethical misconduct and concluded that the commissioner did not violate the Code in this case. The commission does not have authority over state administrative law judges and does not have jurisdiction to review the legal sufficiency of the commissioner's rulings. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed in its entirety pursuant to Rules 16(a) and 23.
